


POPULAR REGIONS AND FUTURE PLANS IN GREECE





MASTER PLAN FOR RAILWAYS

THE MINISTRY OF INFRASTRUCTURE
AND TRANSPORT IS IMPLEMENTING
A €13 BILLION MASTER PLAN DEALING WITH
THE MODERNISATION OF RAILWAYS,
THE EXPANSION OF THE MOTORWAY NETWORK
AND THE TRANSIT SYSTEM.
AN AMENDMENT TO THE PUBLIC
WORKS ACT HAS BEEN
ENACTED THAT PROMISES TO SPEED
UP PROJECTS.







KORFU AIRPORT

ONE OF THE MUST-VISIT POINTS
IN GREECE IS THE AIRPORT ON
THE ISLAND OF CORFU. THE RUNWAY IS
MOSTLY SURROUNDED BY WATER,
AND DURING TAKE-OFF
AND LANDING, THE NEARBY ROAD
IS CLOSED TO VEHICLES.

THE RUNWAY IS MUCH SHORTER THAN THE STANDARD ONE. THE NORM IS ABOUT 2800 M,
WHILE THE ONE IN CORFU IS 2375 M.
THESE 450 M DIFFERENCE IS A LOT.
PILOTS ARRIVING ON THE ISLAND MUST HAVE ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS TO LAND ON SHORTER RUNWAYS.

ATENY AIRPORT

ATHENS AIRPORT ELEFTHERIOS VENIZELOS.
INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT LOCATED 25 KM
EAST OF THE CENTER OF ATHENS IN SPATA.
IT IS THE LARGEST AIRPORT IN GREECE
AND THE MAIN HUB OF OLYMPIC AIRLINES.
PASSENGER TRAFFIC IS HANDLED
BY TWO TERMINALS: THE
MAIN TERMINAL AND THE SATELLITE TERMINAL,
CONNECTED BY A TUNNEL WITH THE
MAIN TERMINAL.

IT HAS TWO RUNWAYS WITH
A LENGTH OF ABOUT 4 KM. THE AIRPORT
IS TO BE EXPANDED OVER THE NEXT
FEW YEARS TO ACCOMMODATE
THE GROWTH OF AIR TRANSPORT.
THE MAIN TERMINAL SERVES
ALL INTRA-SCHENGEN FLIGHTS
AS WELL AS SOME NON-SCHENGEN FLIGHTS.
SATELLITE TERMINAL
IT ONLY SERVES FLIGHTS
OUTSIDE THE SCHENGEN AREA.




SKIATHOS AIRPORT

THE AIRPORT AT SKIATHOS IS FAMOUS
FOR ITS SHORT RUNWAY OF 1,628M.
THANKS TO THIS, WE CAN ADMIRE THE
AMAZING LANDINGS OF PLANES
A FEW METERS OVERHEAD. WHEN THE PLANE
STARTS TO TAKE OFF YOU CAN FEEL
VERY STRONG GUSTS FROM THE
JET ENGINES DURING WHICH YOU ARE UNABLE
TO STAND STILL.

SKIATHOS IS SECOND ONLY
TO SAINT MAARTEN (CARIBBEAN),
THE MOST ATTRACTIVE AIRPORT IN TERMS
OF LOW LANDINGS AND THE POSSIBILITY
OF EXPERIENCING A JET BLAST.
THE LARGEST AIRCRAFT LANDING
AT SKIATHOS IS A BOEING 757,
AS THE RUNWAY IS TOO
SHORT FOR LARGER PLANES.
